Since the first graduation ceremony in 2005, over 550 working professionals employed in St. Johns and surrounding counties have obtained their degrees from Flagler College.

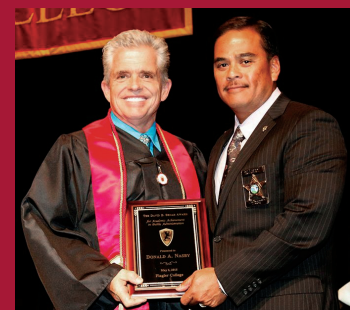
Several forms of financial aid are available, and Florida residents who have not previously earned a bachelor's degree should qualify for the Florida Resident Access Grant (FRAG). The Public Administration Program's total tuition charges for full-time students who qualify for the FRAG is \$600 for the entire academic year.
