Program Requirements

Admission is open to professionals who are employed full-time in public service and non-profit agencies in our region.

Applications are invited from students who have earned one or more of the following:
Associate of Arts degree, or *Associate of Science degree, or *60 transferable college credits in which a grade of C or better was earned from a regionally accredited college or university.

Students with military coursework may be eligible to transfer up to 15 credit hours toward general education or elective coursework. Students with law enforcement, fire service, EMS or corrections certification coursework may be eligible to transfer up to 15 credit hours toward elective coursework. Transfer credit is assigned by the Registrar.

**May require additional courses to meet Flagler's general education requirements.*

Grants Available

Grants subject to annual legislative approval.
Several forms of financial aid are available, and Florida residents who have not previously earned a bachelor's degree should qualify for the Effective Access to Student Educational Grant (EASE). The Public Administration Program's total tuition charges for full-time students who qualify for the EASE is \$1,379 for the entire academic year.
